IMA CHAMPALI away in good order, moved a bit closer four wide in some traffic late turn, lost some ground into the stretch, got back to the leaders nearing the furlong marker, slight drift, clear, driving. BATTLE SWEEP chased the early leader off the inside, challenged between foes turning for home, could not match the winner late, held the place. GLENDA'S MAHALO forwardly placed early outside, advanced and challenged three wide into the lane, narrowly showed the way past the furlong marker, faltered in the late going. SALTY SID off the pace and well out in the strip, four wide into the turn, fanned five wide out of the bend, went evenly through the lane. TUPELO PLAYBOY forwardly placed early along the inside, faded. CAN'T COMPLAIN broke sharp, soon got clear, set the pace for a half then began to weaken when headed. TWO CROWNS was not a serious threat while off the inside. LATCH LIGHTING trailed throughout in a dull effort.
