MS AMBER CAT away in good order, cleared to the inside before the turn, rated through the bend, shook clear upper stretch, maintained a comfortable advantage to the wire under steady handling. OUR SAINT off the pace, improved while saving ground through the turn, moved out slightly for the drive, could do little with the winner the final furlong, clearly second best. TRULY YOU off the pace, fanned six wide turning for home, staged a mild rally to finish best of the rest. ANNA CANA within striking distance, steered out four wide turning for home, came up empty for the drive. TRUE BLONDE SLEW fell back to trail, improved position slightly, no real threat. RULER OF MY HEART pressured winner for three furlong, weakened. INTO THE RUSH was never a threat. SHIRLEE'S GLOW off a bit slow, moved up, five wide and between rivals exiting the turn, had little left for the stretch run.
