REAGAN TRINITY off slowly, moved up to settle mid pack inside, moved closer into the far turn while continuing to save ground, angled out in traffic late in that bend to challenge, kicked strongly clear in a professional effort. GOOD NIGHT got out a bit into the first turn, continued outside while prompting the pace, four wide out of the final turn, came back for the place while no threat to the winner. MAVS ELYANA took over soon after the start, clear in the first tu4m, continued to maintain a daylight advantage into and through the far turn, also was no match for the winner in the drive, weakened late, caught for the place. RED HOT TAMALE off a step slow, showed no early speed, dropped inside, advanced while saving ground second turn, got through then flattened out the final furlong. PEACE N LOVE lacked speed outside, raced five down to four wide in the second turn, failed to respond when set down for the drive. APRIL SIMONE within striking distance early, fell steadily back to trail in the second turn, moved out widest for the drive, lacked a closing kick. NATIVIUS closest to the leader, was beginning to tire in traffic late in the second turn when shuffled back, continued to fade stretch.
