Footnotes

PARQUETERIE stalked the leaders in the second flight off the inside, ranged up three wide to challenge midway on the final turn, came four wide into the stretch, shook clear late, enough to last in the final strides. TWO PUNCH GIRL also in the second group, saved ground, boxed in for most of the final turn, got through approaching the furlong marker, rallied willingly up the rail while to late for the win, up final strides for the place. RAIN CLOUD raced back off the early pace, made a good gain into contention with a four wide advance second turn, floated out five wide by the winner turning for home when challenging, hung in the final furlong. ISLAND PRINCESS in mid pack early, behind traffic when moving a bit closer late in the final turn, angled in upper stretch, lodged a brief bid past the furlong marker and then also flattened out. INTERLUDE lacked speed, waited briefly behind horses late in the final turn, moved out a bit for room, came up empty for the drive. LEESTOWN FLASH dwelt at the start, trailed, five wide turning for home, lacked a significant late kick while picking off a couple of tiring rivals. SWAMP LAST CHANCE pressured the pace for six furlong and gave way. PEACE N LOVE narrowly set the pace along the inside, stopped when headed by the winner turning for home.
