### Footnotes

IRENE'S WILD ROSE with the pace from the start outside, dueled through the turn while in hand, disposed of the other speed entering the stretch to be clear, kept to task to the wire. JACKIE LANE broke out, brushed, raced behind the leaders, moved closer in the three path late in the turn, could do little with the winner the final furlong, well clear of the others. RULERS STAR with the early pace while between rivals, dueled through the turn inside the winner, no match for that one or the runner up, comfortably saved the show. TUNNELFORMONEY pinched back at the start, trailed for a half, picked off a couple of faltering foes while never dangerous. WIN FOR PLEASURE broke in, brushed, moved up closer into the turn, began to fade before a half. SMOKE HARBOR broke sharp, flashed brief speed inside, stopped, distanced.
