JET G PRIDE set the pace along the inside, shook clear turning for home, held the runner up comfortably safe late under steady handling. WELL GO THEN behind the pace toward the inside, raced in some close quarters past the furlong marker, came off the rail a bit late and finished willingly. MITZI'S OATES off a bit slow, trailed well back for a half, found best stride too late inside of most rivals. EASTERN MEMORY pressured the winner to that one's outside, weakened in the drive. LITTLE SHON forwardly placed on the outside, came up empty for the drive. ZIGNOR failed to fire from off the pace. I DIG U steadily faded. TINNERS BUCKS came wide into the stretch, gave way.
