PINEVILLE four wide in the first turn when forwardly placed, took over onto the backstretch, set the pace while rating, turned back a bid in upper straight, brushed, well clear again late. WAKE UP SAL prompted the pace, advanced to challenge turning for home, brushed, no match late, clearly second best. SPIDERMAN RIDGE well off the pace for six furlongs, advanced inside of traffic late second turn, no late gain on the top two, best rest. LITTLE CARSON showed the way early inside, pulled hard first turn, allowed the pace to go backstretch, continued to save ground, evenly in the drive. SOLAR OBSERVATORY went evenly throughout in the three path. RANGE MAN moved a bit closer while four wide in the second turn, tired in the drive. MAGIC TEMPLE five wide out of the final turn, failed to rally. GOLD SOUK saved ground to no avail. J D'S SILVER JETT was never involved.
