Footnotes

RAIDER WELLS devoid of early foot, began a five wide rally midway on the final turn, continued widest in the drive, in time. LUCKY A. C. moved up to vie for the lead soon after the start, dueled second turn and into the lane, led late, nipped at wire. STONE SKIPPER settled off the pace, came three wide in the second flight into the lane, drifted out midstretch, closed ground, finished between the top two. PATSY'S PROM DATE off the early pace while a bit rank in traffic first turn, moved out, middle move four wide far turn, dueled, led, faltered late. BEE TREE off the early pace inside, steadied along the rail first turn, evenly paced, not dangerous. DEACON BOB behind the pace, roused off the inside late in the final turn, lacked a significant response. IT'S NOT PERSONAL lacked speed, came five wide out of the final turn, passed tiring foes. EASTERNER set or forced the pace for five furlongs, gave way. BARRY'S SONG broke slowly, ever a threat. FIEND A BIT five down to four wide in the first turn, advanced, four wide second turn, tired in the drive. MARKSVILLE had speed for a half and stopped. STANS MR. BUSTER bothered slightly in some traffic early in the first turn, also stopped.
