LINNIE LAURINE broke out to bother SMOKE HARBOR slightly, contested the pace while three wide, continued to vie turn, pulled away through the stretch under steady handling. MALIBU DAY contested the pace while between rivals, fell back a bit late in the turn, proved determined for the place while along the inside through the lane. LIFE IS BUT ADREAM lacked speed, came in the three path into the lane, along for the show while not a threat to the top pair. BUTTON off the pace and the rail for a half, improved position late while also not a serious threat to the top two. CAJUN CHEROKEE hopped at the start, moved to race midpack, advanced a bit closer when five wide late in the turn, flattened out in the drive. MY BAZINGA pressed the issue from the outside and and four wide for a half and tired. SMOKE HARBOR bothered at the start, trailed for a half, passed tiring rivals. FANTASY CODE with the pace for four furlongs along the inside, gave way. MOLLY B broke to the inside, was never a factor. SO LITERATE backed up in the drive.
