KIM'S PRETTY KAREN outrun in the early going, squeezed through a narrow opening midstretch when rallying, continued willingly to the finish to be in time. CURLEY KIM within striking distance early toward the inside, shuffled back into the turn, moved outside, three wide into the lane, up for the place. MISS SALTi off a bit slow, used to move up into contention through the turn, bid, took over, faltered in the late going. A BIT TOUCHY lacked speed, improved position through traffic while not dangerous for the win. LEEVILLE off the pace, roused four wide in the turn, went evenly through the stretch. JOSATA chased the leader for a half, weakened. BOOZY ROUGE sprinted clear to set the pace, gave way when confronted for the drive. GIANT APPEAL steadied at the start, trailed throughout.
