ROMAN FOREST last away, moved up to race within striking distance, bit closer in traffic turn, split foes under clever handling with less than a furlong remaining, proved best in game fashion. KRISTYS MARQ forwardly placed and outside, ranged up to challenge three wide in the turn, narrowly showed the way into the stretch and past the furlong marker, outfinished by the winner in the final strides. LAGNIAPPE IN B S L void of speed, came five wide out of the turn when beginning to rally, finished well to be clear of the others. WHAT A TRIBUTE in the second group while toward the inside, boxed in while racing inside the winner late in the turn, continued toward the rail, altered course to the outside midstretch, managed some late gain while not a serious threat for the win. JOE THE HAT narrowly set the pace while off the inside, vied between rivals into the lane, weakened the final furlong. ADDISON'S HOPE close up early inside, fell back, moved out to be four wide for the drive, came up empty. INTINCTION remained back throughout. JOHN LOUIS CLASSIC vied up front along the inside for three furlongs, gave way in the drive.
