WIMBLEDON STAR behind the first group, came three wide into the lane, roused, bid, clear, kept to task. SECRETS KEPT devoid of speed for a half, called on for some run into the lane while off the inside, was going well late to be clear for the place. YES IT'S FRIDAY away in good order, showed the way early inside, vied through the turn and into the lane, proved game for the show. LITTLE SANTAYA broke alertly, pressured the early leader, going that one from the outside turn, put a head in front with a quarter left, continued to show the way past the furlong marker, weakened. TIGER'S SPLENDOR forwardly placed, challenged on the outside turn, got out a bit to be four wide into the lane, drifted out nearing the furlong marker and also weakened. RUSTY CODE was finished early, trailed home.
