Footnotes

SENT lacked speed, came three wide out of the final turn, set down, finished willingly to be up in time. ABBY THE GREAT saved ground while off the pace, moved out for room when entering the straight, rallied well through traffic and finished between foes and on equal terms with two other rivals in a triple dead heat for the place. FRESH pressured the leader from the outside, moved up to engage that rival into the far turn, vied into the lane, gained the advantage and proved stubborn to the end. BONNIES JUDGE forwardly placed and three wide, fell back a bit when straightened for home, came again from between foes to earn part of the place while inside the winner. MARKED TIME broke on top, got clear before a quarter, continued to show the way while rating, responded when challenged second turn, vied past the furlong marker then weakened late. SAMBA G void of speed, raced in some traffic while three wide into the lane, improved position. CAPOTETTA within striking distance while toward the inside, came up empty in the drive. ASHLEE'S MOM off a bit slow, trailed much of the way, passed some tiring rivals after the issue had been decided. XIANO four wide through the first turn, raced four out to five wide through the second bend, lacked a rally. TERRI'S APTITUDE raced back, encountered some traffic turning for home, lacked room, moved out to be six wide, failed to muster a late response. SMOOTH SEA four wide through both turns, tired in the drive.
