Footnotes

ROCKGLEN away in good order, vied and narrowly set the pace closest to the inside, in hand turn, held sway late under steady handling. WILBY'S RAY behind the pace early, continued in the second flight while between foes turn, set down while off the inside for the drive, finished willingly to earn the place. SULTRY GENTLEMAN also in the second group, restrained while saving ground late in the turn, rail finish, outkicked for the place spot. LEESTOWN GIFT vied up front while outside the winner and between foes, closest to the victor a furlong out, had little left in the late going. CAN'T COMPLAIN broke with the field, forced the early pace, vied four wide into and through much of the turn to lose some ground, came up empty in the drive. LOUISIANA DUDE with the pace for three furlongs while three wide, weakened in the drive. PRINCE OF APRIL void of speed, moved out to be four wide turning for home, lacked a rally.
