METEOR ATTACK within striking distance early, steadied in tight quarters midway up the backstretch, fell back, encountered traffic into the lane, moved out slightly for room, split foes and proved best. SNOW ON THE BAYOU away in good order, fell back off the pace, advanced into contention four wide through the turn, roused for the drive, brief bid, no match for the winner late, held the place. PRINCE OF FIRE off a bit slow, continued to trail for a half, angled out for the drive, called on for some run and was going well at the end out in the strip while too late. SEEKINGACURE broke sharp, raced back off the pace, rail trip throughout, improved position. OVERNIGHT FLIGHT set or forced the pace closest to but not on the rail, narrowly showed the way past the furlong marker, weakened. ADLIS vied up front, got briefly clear in the turn, faltered in the drive. OSIDY AGAIN forwardly placed in the early going, faded in the three path. MISSIN HOME was never involved.
