ROUNDABOUT JONES moved up to clear early, dueled through the turn, shook off the other speed turning for home, drew out, driving. DUSTY TUNNEL within striking distance toward the inside, came off the inside when roused exiting the turn, edged clear for the place late. BADA IN NEVADA moved up, dueled through the turn outside the winner, weakened drive, caught for the place. NO TOLERANCE went evenly paced throughout well off the inside. SUMMERTIME MOOD lacked the necessary closing response. SHOT GUN TERRY bothered a foe early, made little additional impact. PRIVATE AMERICAN bothered soon after the start, remained back. CAYENNE THE MAN forwardly placed early, begin to fade before a half. EL RAJA fell back soon after the start, distanced after losing contact with the field.
