IZZY GOLDEN away in good order to be with the pace from the beginning, shook clear in the turn, maintained a comfortable advantage through the stretch under steady handling. JOE'S WITNESS lacked speed, came into the stretch in the three path, steered out a bit, finished up willingly to earn the place. CORN DOG off a bit slow, used some early to reach a forward position, closest to the winner late, nipped for the place. RARE LUKEY vied early while between foes and outside the winner, chased that one through the turn and upper stretch, weakened a bit in the late going. MAN IN COMMAND fell back after racing briefly with the first flight, two path turn, went evenly through the stretch. GEAX TIGER lacked speed, raced five wide into the stretch, improved position. FIFTH DOWN fell well back early, displayed a modest amount of late interest up the rail while not a serious threat. BEN'S YO lacked a rally in the drive. CATOFNINELIVES tired racing three wide. EXPLOSIVE BUZZ vied up front early on the outside and gave way before three furlongs. HUANA CREEK broke in the air and trailed most of the way. CHIP'S BIGBOY four wide through the turn, faded.
