FOR TWO YEAR OLDS. (Includes \$50,000.00 from Slot Revenue). WEIGHTS: 121lbs. Nom nomination fee, \$250 to pass the entry box and an additional \$250 to start with \$50,000 Guaranteed to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth, 3% to fifth with any unpaid monies reverting to the purse account. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Preference to horses with the highest earnings in 2009. Different owners will have equal draw according to weights. The second part of same owner entries will have no consideration over a single interest. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees. The owner of the winner to receive a trophy. Nominations closed Saturday, August 1, 2009 with 38 nominees. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at 1 Mile and 70 Yards).

Footnotes

FORESTRY STEEL outrun in the early going, continued to race back into the lane, four wide, roused, long drive, all out to prove narrowly best. PRINCE EDDINGTON set or forced the pace along the inside and proved stubborn to the end. NOCKNONHEAVENSGATE fell back off the pace, saved all the ground, continued along the rail stretch, not enough in the late going while in just a bit tight. MCKENNA'S JUSTICE void of speed in trailing, four wide out of the final turn, raced widest down the lane, closed the gap. PERFECT LOU allowed to settle, raced in tight quarters through much of the stretch, steadied when in the tightest late, did not recover. MIDWAY TAP bore out a bit into the first turn, raced forwardly in prompting the pace off the inside, lugged in to tighten foes up late. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INVOLVING THE RUN IN DEEP STRETCH, MIDWAY TAP WAS DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED EIGHTH. SPEIGHTSTOWN SON hopped at the start, raced off the pace, lacked a late punch behind traffic. B'WANAGOLDMINE prompted the pace, heavy traffic late when within striking distance, took up late to lose all chance.
