DAWN BEFORE DAWN behind the pace, advanced the middle half, roused for the drive, slight drift out, was not making much headway on the leader when that one ducked into the rail just inside the furlong marker, inherited advantage. ADAYINSPAIN settled off the pace, bothered slightly midstretch, moved out a bit, finished willingly to be up for the place while between foes late. GRAYNESS lacked speed, rallied off the inside, missed the place. HUMBLE ANNE forwardly placed, closest to the leader stretch, was going evenly when that one ducked into the rail, weakened a bit late and was outfinished for the place. AUTUM'S DELIGHT went evenly paced throughout. COUNTRY CAUCUS broke on top, showed some brief speed, retreated. TWICE AS NICE failed to menace. OUR FOUR QUEENS made little impact. FLAT OUT FAST remained always back. BALLISTAE took command soon after the start, got well clear in the run up the backstretch, was still comfortably in front in midstretch when shown a right-handed whip, ducked into the rail, unseated rider.
