Footnotes

SEASONED unhurried early, began a steady gain on the outside early in the second turn, collared the leader late and proved best. KUTTER CREEK settled off the pace, advanced on the leaders out of the final turn, challenged three wide past the furlong marker, led late, caught by the winner final strides. INDICATION forwardly placed, challenge off the inside in the second turn, not enough in the drive, saved the show. DREAMSALIVE within striking distance, boxed in briefly in the second turn while continuing along the inside, came up empty when clear for the drive. CHANEL NUMBER MINE set or forced the pace while inside, weakened in the drive. JOZI'S TURN pressured the pace for five furlongs and had little left. TERRI'S APTITUDE lacked a rally. BERRY VALID was never close. MAUI CRUSIER was finished after four furlongs.
