MR. ETBAUER took control soon after the start, set all the pace, drew out to a long lead when straightened for home, maintained a comfortable advantage to the wire. COVERT OPS settled off the pace, roused for the drive, lodged a willingly rally to be clearly second best while no match for the winner. CASINO SPORT away in good order, fell back, along for the show while no threat to the top pair. COUNTDOWN SHOWDOWN void of speed, picked off a couple of tiring rivals while also not posing a serious threat. FATHERS BAD BOY forwardly placed for a half, backed up in the drive. LOUISVILLE RIDGE chased the winner for a half and gave way. BIGOLCOUNTRYBOY last to leave, was never close.
