**Footnotes**

SWOROVSKI back off the pace two off the inside, moved a bit closer in some traffic into the far turn, came off the inside nearing the furlong marker, roused, in time. MEZCAL VIBE prompted the early leader, moved up inside that rival to take over in the second turn, shook clear stretch, could not contain the winner. GRANTSTER tracked the pace from along the inside, a bit tentative midstretch while continuing along the inside, up for show when clear. DEPUTY DEHERE lacked speed, behind horses into the lane, improved position late while still surrounded by rivals. HORNITO did not break with the field, remained back into the far turn, came five wide into the straight, displayed a modest amount of late interest to improve position a bit. GULUK BOY within striking distance, lacked a late punch. SLEW SALUTE broke in, straightened to set the pace off the inside, headed far turn, weakened. MIDTOWN GROOM broke out helping to pinch back a couple of rivals, raced forwardly and three wide, gave way in the second turn. SIXTY SECONDS JOE pinched back at the start, 4w 1st turn, continued outside, tired. MINEISCOOKIN' pinched back at the start, trailed well back throughout.
