Footnotes

MS TEQUILA SHEILA outrun in the early going, moved slightly closer toward the inside into the turn, angled out midway on the bend, challenged while widest of the first flight past the furlong marker, gained the advantage, dug in late to prove best. TIGER GATE fractious while loading, broke slowly, raced back, steered out stretch, closed ground, late bid, missed. WITCHY LADY forwardly placed, saved ground into the stretch, challenged along the rail midstretch, flattened out the final sixteenth. LIL MISS LEXI alternated up front while racing off the inside, faltered in the final furlong. BUTTON set or forced the pace closest to but not on the inside, allowed a rival the rail nearing the furlong grounds when beginning to tire, continued to weaken to the wire. TICKET TO HEAVEN lacked speed, raced four wide through the turn, failed to muster a rally. PICK OF THE SANDS fell back to trail after the start, showed little.
