STARTEX away well, pressured the early leader from along the inside, moved on that rival and put a head in front midway on the second while continuing inside, drove steadily clear. JUMP IN LINE within striking distance, three wide into the lane, proved no match for the winner, slight drift midstretch, clear for the place. MAJHOOD last to leave, lacked speed, angled out a bit to be four wide turning for home, slight bother when the runner up drifted out a bit with a furlong to run, finished up best of the rest. K ONE FOUR within striking distance along the inside, fell back a bit into and through the final turn, continued to save ground into the stretch, went evenly to the wire. NO REGRET trailed much of the way, picked off a couple of tiring rivals after the issue had been decided. AFTERMEYOUREFIRST four wide through the first turn when within striking distance, four out to five wide in the second bend, tired in the drive. EVIL OFFICER broke alertly, narrowly showed the way for almost six furlongs outside the winner, gave way when headed by that rival midway on the final turn.
