Weight: 122 lbs. Footnotes

TENSAS HARBOR unhurried in the early going, asked along in the three path in the second turn, steered out widest once straightened for home, closed with good late energy to win going away. MISS GOODTHING allowed the pace to go after breaking in good order, advanced on that rival off the inside in the second turn, took over entering the stretch, showed the way past the furlong marker but proved no match for the winner late, lasted for the place. ANTE UP ANNIE lacked early foot, saved ground, firmly in hand along the rail and in some traffic a quarter mile out, moved out, rallied, getting to the runner up late. KISSES FOR CARROTS bobbled at the start, quickly recovered to race closest to the leader, challenged between horses entering the stretch, had little left in the late going. TUJUACAGOFAST went evenly while racing in the two path. MISCHIEVOUS MAMA broke sharply, quickly sprinted well clear, long lead middle half, gave way when headed turning for home. ROYAL RUSH last to leave, trailed most of the way, passed tiring rivals. ZARA LAUREN steadily faded. UNDER THE RADAR never involved, trailed home.
