CHRISTAVILLA away, cleared into the turn, maintained a daylight advantage through the stretch under steady handling. MEDIEVAL JAZZ off a bit slow, rallied up the rail, finished well to be second best. DUPLICATE AWARD forwardly placed, raced off the rail into the stretch, finished best of the rest. SUNNY'S SOCIALITE failed to seriously menace while off the inside. ONCE A PROMISE lacked early foot, improved position through traffic while also never a threat for the win. TELL ME SWEETLY in traffic turning for home, lacked a late bid. BROADCASTING showed little in a dull effort. GRAIN OF SALT forwardly placed for a half, backed up through the stretch. CRIMSON B B finished early, trailed home.
