LUCKY TRADITION moved up inside to show the way through the first turn, dueled middle half, shook off the other speed, drew out steadily in the drive while being kept to task. MIDWAY TAP forwardly placed, moved up to duel the middle half, no match for the winner in the drive, remained clear for the place. MARKET MOVER last away, raced well back early, steadily advanced, continued to rally through traffic to earn the show. WAJIR ON ME within striking distance, came up empty for the drive. THEATRICAL'S HALO completely devoid of speed for six furlongs, came four wide out of the final turn, staged a mild, belated rally. WHOLELOTAKING lacked a response in the drive. REWIRING four wide early in the first turn, also remained back in lacking a late bid. BELFAST never involved, well beaten. WACO ZONE chased the early leader, stopped after a half, distanced after losing contact with the field in the drive.
