BURNING RAGE bothered at the start, settled off the pace and the inside, moved closer three wide second turn, challenged, showed the way past the furlong marker, held off the runner up late while drifting out. CALLTHEWITCH off the pace, in some traffic when moving within striking distance late in the second turn, got clear, late bid, carried out, outfinished. ALONG void of early foot, continued to trail into the far turn, found her best stride too late, along for the show, no match for the top two. ART DESIGN dueled early, got clear before a half, continued to show the way second turn, weakened in the drive. SILVER BULLET GAL broke out, dueled early, chased the leader into the far turn, retreated after racing four wide late in the final turn. RUN AND COLLECT five wide into the first turn, continued to race wide and failed to threaten. NETTIE HUGHES pinched back at the start, raced in some traffic then moved out to be five wide into the straight, failed to rally. PHANTOM OPERA broke out, was straightened to race within striking distance, had little left for the drive. NASTYLEGS RIDGE never menaced.
