GET IN DA HOUSE unhurried in the early going, advanced on the outside in the second turn, came five wide into the stretch when challenging, brushed, gained the advantage and kicked well clear. HEAVY ON THEMISTER restrained while off the pace, brushed while four wide and inside the winner exiting the turn, no match for that foe, proved game for the place. STRING KING forwardly placed, moved a bit closer while three wide into and through the second turn, between foes late, not enough for the place. AMANECER DE ORO pressed early, took over before a half, set the pace inside, weakened late. EXPRESSIANO last to leave, trailed for six furlongs, four wide into the lane, displayed a modest amount of late interest. ONE PRETTY PENNY broke alertly, set the early pace inside, gave way after a half. OLD ROME never menaced off the inside. TRICKY AND QUICK faded after a half.
