SUPER DOCTOR close from the start, vied between foes through the turn, finished with good resolve the final furlong under firm handling to prove best. GOLDEN SOL off the early pace, ranged up five wide to challenge turning for home, lost some ground into the lane, could not get all the way back to the winner, gained the nod for the place. FANTASTICAL with the pace while four wide through the turn, also lost some ground to the winner into the stretch, missed the place. ARROWMAKER with the pace, raced three wide and between foes through the bend, weakened the final furlong. KIOWA'S SECRET a pace factor for a half closest to the inside, faltered in the drive. J. R. STEAMER failed to rally. DUSTIN DUDE well back early, picked off a couple of tiring foes after the issue had been decided. MACEY'S CAREBELL raced briefly forward in the early going, faded. SILKY SLEET was never close.
