TOCCET LAUNCH devoid of early foot, continued to trail second turn, swung out to be five wide for the drive, late bid, in time. STONE SKIPPER forwardly placed, allowed the pace to go after a quarter, continued patient handling second turn, moved out for room late 2nd turn, bid midstretch, took over, nipped at the wire. PRISCILLA'S BOY lacked speed, swung out to be five wide in front of the winner turning for home, could not match that one late, mild rally to pick up the show. ULTRA CLASSIC narrowly set the pace, garnered a slightly larger lead into the stretch, faltered when headed the final furlong. HIGH LOW GAME went evenly paced throughout in the two path. PRECOCIOUS ZAK lacked early foot, failed to rally in the drive. DUBLIN ROAD dueled up front while off the inside, the first to falter. SAINT RAYMOND was finished after a half. RED RIVER KING forwardly placed, three wide challenge late second turn, stopped in the drive.
