THIEF OF HEARTS off the pace and the inside, roused for the drive, split foes late and finished willingly to be in time. GOLDATWORK lacked speed, came four wide when rallying into the stretch, late bid widest of the first flight, outkicked to wire. ROYAL STAG cleared early, set the pace, clear again briefly midstretch, gave ground grudgingly to the top two in the late going. LOKARI chased the early leader, lodged a mild bid late in the turn, faltered in the drive. FANTASY CRUISE within striking distance in the turn, had little left for the drive. WHIRLING NORTH lacked a late bid. JOEBY THE MONEY was never involved. AGERE hopped at the start, moved up, faded.
