BULLY BOY broke on top, showed the way into the turn just off the inside, lugged in when straightened for home, drifted out soon after, came out again under a left handed whip to bother RED SPIRIT a furlong out, kept that same foe at bay to the wire under firm handling. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS' INQUIRY AND A CLAIM OF FOUL BY THE RIDER OF RED SPIRIT AGAINST THE WINNER FOR INTERFERENCE IN MIDSTRETCH, BULLY BOY WAS DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED SECOND. RED SPIRIT restrained and off the pace early, moved closer out of the turn while between rivals, impeded when BULLY BOY drifted out in midstretch, could not get back to that rival late. HE BE WILD lacked speed, continued to be well back out of the turn when five wide, displayed some energy down the middle of the strip while too late. CLINEY off the pace and the inside, raced six wide out of the turn, went evenly to the wire. BWANA vied up front off the inside, gave way in the drive. ERRONEOUS TOO within striking distance for three furlongs outside, also backed up through the stretch. ROSSINI'S EMINENCE last away, trailed throughout.
