Footnotes

J. B.'S MARQUIS outrun in the early going, began to advance along the inside far turn, moved out a bit and split foes into the lane, angled out a bit further and ran by the leader. BEAUTY'S PIONEER closest to the early leader, moved up to duel outside that rival before a half, disposed of that same foe to be clear past the furlong marker, proved no match for the winner, remained clear for the place. NUBBY DUCKS carried out a bit into the first turn when in a forward position, continued to race within striking distance, lacked a winning kick in the drive. A MILLION FIELDS allowed to settle off the pace, roused four wide late in the final turn, came up empty for the drive. ZARB'S CHAMPION lacked speed, carried out a bit to be five wide out of the final turn, made little impact in the drive. DYNAMIC RESOURCE away best of all, set the early pace inside, dueled the middle half while continuing closest to the inside, weakened. MASTER WAGON broke slowly and was never involved. STOOPS HALO a bit rank in the early going, forced the issue and stopped.
