Footnotes

PELHAM back off the pace for six furlongs, came five wide into the lane when beginning to rally, continued willingly to the finish to be in time. MASTER WAGON outrun in the early going, raced in some traffic into and through upper stretch, clear late, also was going well at the end. WITS END settled off the pace and the inside, ranged up, challenged four wide into the lane, showed the way past the furlong marker, could not contain the top two late. SIXTY SECONDS JOE lacked speed for six furlongs, traffic late in the final turn, improved position in the drive after moved out a bit for room. K ONE FOUR within striking distance off the inside, vied three wide and between rivals into the stretch, weakened final furlong. JUMP JUMP raced off the pace, lacked a response in the drive. COUSIN KEVIN vied early, got clear before a half, vied into the stretch and gave way. SUMKINDAKICK set or forced the pace, faltered in the drive. BIG LEVI raced briefly forward, staged a steady retreat before a half.
