### Footnotes

COWBOY CADILLAC outrun in the early going, four wide advance then challenged into the lane, put a head in front when straightened for home, long drive, held late. FANTASY MAN off a step slow, raced back, began to move after a half, also raced four wide second turn, traffic into the lane, roused, finished willingly to be getting to the winner. GAME PLAY'S ICON forward from the start, vied in the run up the backstretch and into the far turn off the inside, narrow advantage into the stretch, gave ground grudgingly. TIME IS CRUCIAL four wide in the first turn, raced within striking distance, slight drive in the lane, finished up evenly. CONDOBOUND parked out five wide through the first turn continued outside, had little left for the drive. MR. ROAD WARRIOR forwardly placed for six furlongs, weakened. RYNO'S HOMERUN raced inside, began to fall back after a half. GEOTZ DISASTER off slow, trailed early, moved up six wide in the second turn, hung in the drive. DOT'S IMP also six wide late in the final turn, failed to rally. SOCKET set the early pace inside, vied into far turn, stopped.
