GOING TO THE SUN stalked the pace while toward the inside, waited briefly behind horses late second turn, moved out four wide entering the stretch, bid a furlong out, drew clear. SOUTHPINE in the second flight outside the winner, moved on the leaders and put a head in front three wide late in the second turn, equal terms with the winner past the furlong marker, no match late, clearly second best. SERA'S TUNNEL settled off the pace, came five wide into the lane, finished up best of the rest. VERA BELLE lacked speed past the wire the first time, checked up trying to avoid a stricken foe into the first turn, forced very wide, fell far back, showed some belated interest after the issue had been decided. SAHARA SULTAN off the pace while in hand and off the inside, four wide in the second turn, failed to muster much of a response when asked in the drive. QUE HORA ES pressured the pace off the inside, gave way in the drive. ELEVENTH HOUR narrowly set the pace for six furlongs, faltered when headed turning for home. ELUSIVE GRACE was racing well back off the pace when forced to take up and go extremely wide to avoid a stricken foe into the first turn, lost all chance. DREAMSALIVE bore out into the first turn, was never a threat inside. FETCH YOU BACK in traffic, forced out and across SERA'S TUNNEL'S heels into the first turn, clipped, lost rider. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS' INQUIRY REGARDING THE INCIDENT ENTERING THE FIRST TURN, THE ORIGINAL ORDER OF FINISH REMAINED THE SAME.
