CHOCTAW BILL forwardly placed inside, checked up in tight quarters into the first turn, continued to stalk inside, steadied late in the second turn when lacking room, angled out, strong bid, gained the advantage, outkicked the runner up the final furlong. LUCKY SEVENTEEN void of early foot, rallied on the outside into the lane, raced on equal terms with the winner nearing the furlong marker, could not match that foe late. ROCKITTOWN steadied slightly in traffic into the first turn, raced back, came four wide and behind the runner up into the stretch, roused, slowly gaining on the top two. HENNYS HOPE evenly paced off the inside, moved a bit closer in the three path late in the final turn, lacked a further advance. DAVY'S PRODUCTION cleared to the inside first turn, set the pace until turning for home, faltered when headed. MY TICKET steadied in between foes into the first turn, failed to threaten. WITH ATTITUDE last to leave, moved up to prompt the pace for six furlongs, stopped in the drive.
