GOING TO THE SUN settled in the second flight off the inside, engaged the leader turning for home, wore that foe down under steady handling. RESTLESS STAR dueled up front, garnered a larger lead through the second turn, could not match the winner the final furlong. AMERICAN SULU raced in the second group inside the winner, moved around a tiring foe in the second turn, could not match that foe or the runner up in the drive, clear of the others. CAJUN HOSPITALITY void of early foot, continued to race back, picked up a couple of faltering foes late in the final turn, made little impact in the drive. TIZ HOO lacked a rally. COUNTRY CAUCUS four wide into the first turn, never a factor. CITY DANCING dueled up front inside the runner up, stopped in the second turn, distanced.
