Footnotes

DAPHNE'S TRIBUTE in the second flight early while inside, angled out in preparation for the drive carrying FAIR VICTORY out entering the stretch, outside bid midstretch, clear, ducked in late, kept to task. FINE TROUBLEMAKER dueled up front along the inside, put the other speed away turning for home to garner a larger lead, narrowly showed the way past the furlong marker inside the winner, no match for that foe, clearly second best. OVER IT broke awkwardly, raced back early as a result, advanced while saving ground through the turn, could do little the top two late, clear of the others. SAIL ON CAPOTE broke out, settled off the pace and the inside, went evenly in the drive. MONKEY HANDS lacked speed, improved position slightly while never dangerous. HIT THAT STRIKE off a bit slow, passed tiring rivals. ERRONEOUS TOO dueled up front off the inside, gave way in the drive. TRUETT'S REBEL was finished early. FAIR VICTORY in the second group, carried out four wide turning for home by the winner, gave way.
