TIZ A SCHOLAR unhurried early, saved ground into the far turn, waited in traffic while continuing inside late in the final turn, got through, rallied up the inside and was edging clear late. MARION PONDEROSA off the early pace, circled to the front while five wide out of the final turn, gained a larger advantage a furlong out, could not contain the winner. YOGI AND BOO BOO four wide when forcing the issue through both turns, remained well clear for the show. NO FLATTERY NEEDED off the early pace, fell further back along the inside late backstretch, trailed into the lane, improved up the rail while not a serious threat. SWEET DIXIELAND within striking distance for six furlongs, lodged a bid between foes turning for home, failed to sustain that effort in the drive. BIRD STORM vied up front while between foes, was beginning to tire when in tight late in the final turn, continued to back up in the drive. MAURICEVILLE narrowly set the pace along the inside, also gave way in the drive.
