HARD CASE forwardly placed along the inside, moved out for room into the stretch, bid past the furlong marker, kicked clear. INTHENICKOFTIME broke alertly, narrowly set the pace two path, could not match the winner late, well clear of the others. MOBEETIE pressed early, dueled through the turn three path, could not keep up in the drive, lasted for the show. SILVER NICKEL went evenly paced throughout in lacking a late bid. CUZ JOLEE made little impact. LEESTOWN HERO was finished early. LUNAR TIDE rank early, bore out then bolted in the turn, pulled up out of the turn.
