Footnotes

CARSON'S TWINKLE used a bit early to make the advantage, rated in the run up the backstretch, continued to rate second turn, opened a sizeable advantage past the furlong marker, enough left to hold off the runner up. LIVEALITTLEBIT stalked the pace off the inside, waited briefly in traffic and three wide late in the final turn, lacked room a furlong out, altered course to the inside, finished willingly while too late. SWEET TEXAS STAR lacked speed while four wide early, continued four path through the second turn, roused turning for home, no match for the top two late. RUDE pressured the winner while in hand and outside that rival, continued to apply pressure second turn, drifted out while tiring stretch. BIENHEUREUX pulled early while behind the pace and well out in the strip, came up empty for the drive. PINEY ROCK failed to menace. MCCLEES CREEK within striking distance for a half, stopped.
