SERVICE HAWK void of early foot, began to move on the outside in the far turn, came four wide into the lane, finished well to be in time. GOLD LINER pressed the early leader, moved up to duel with that one early in the second turn, shook clear when straightened for home, could not contain the winner. MIRAJ settled off the pace, moved a bit closer three wide when roused exiting the final turn, failed to sustain that effort the final furlong. DUSTY TUNNEL raced on the outside throughout, finished up evenly in lacking a final kick. JOHN'S BROWN BEAR set the early pace, vied into the far turn, weakened in the drive. ASHEN LORD remained back throughout. BYE YAWL tired after a half.
