RICH'SLION broke in to bother FLASHY SPLASHY, was straightened then moved up along the inside to take control before a quarter, rated in the run through the turn while continuing along the rail, drew out stretch, driving. GENUINE GENT settled in mid pack while toward the inside, asked along in the turn behind the winner, no match for that one in the drive, fully extended to earn the place. WINDY LOU TOO off a bit slow, well back, moved out widest for the drive, finished willingly to be getting to the runner up. HANG ON forwardly placed for a half while racing outside, had little left for the drive. PRINCE ALEX with the early pace, pressured the winner into and through the turn, weakened in the final furlong. TRAVEL OSIDY made little impact. U R MY LAST CHANCE within striking distance while racing off the inside, lacked a response in the drive. DAY OF THE PLAYER lacked speed, was five wide late in the turn, failed to muster a rally in the drive. FLASHY SPLASHY bothered at the start, raced far back, no factor. DARK SQUIRE steadily faded outside. CHIEF EXE OFFICER was racing in the second when he broke down just before a quarter.
