ONE TRUE SUN last away, raced unhurried for three furlongs, swung out widest for the drive, roused, finished up willingly to be in time. SKINNY MCGINTY vied up front along the inside, held a narrow advantage through the turn and into the stretch, continued to show the way late, could not contain the winner, gained the nod for the place. FREEBIE GOLD forwardly placed from the start, battled for the lead while four wide through the turn, duled past the furlong marker outside the runner up, outnodded for the place by that same rival. RISEN IN DEED close early, fell back off the pace into the turn, moved closer after dropping inside late in the bend, flattened out in the drive. HIGH HAND lacked early foot, improved position a bit in the drive, without posing a serious threat. UNCLE BOBBY behind the first flight early, five wide through the turn, failed to muster a rally when asked in the drive. KENTUCKY BOOTS vied up front while between foes early, gave way turning for home. WILDCAT CHARMS with the early pace while also between rivals, shuffled back midway on the turn, continued to fade through the stretch.
