Footnotes

REWIRING forwardly placed from the start, continued close under restraint up the backstretch, challenged along the rail turning for home, long drive, proved narrowly best in a determined effort. CLEVER SHOES pressured the pace from the outside, lost some ground with a three wide trip out of the final turn, got back to the leaders a furlong out, vied to the wire, outfinished. PRACTICE TEE settled off the pace, in some traffic between rivals second turn, moved inside, up for the show along the rail and behind the winner at the wire. KAT'S COURT lacked speed, continued behind horses into the far turn, traffic a quarter out, between foes much of the lane, displayed a modest amount of late interest. BUTTER BROWN back off the pace and the inside, five out to six wide late in the final turn, went evenly to the wire while remaining well out in the strip. PUTITONWAYNESTAB broke on top, set or forced the pace off the rail, allowed the winner the inside turning for home, vied with that foe past the furlong marker, gave way late. C P IMPROVISE raced in mid pack, outside and five wide late in the final turn, failed to muster a rally in the drive. TEENAGER IN LOVE was finished early.
