SIR RABBIT patiently handled outside while within striking distance, moved a bit closer second turn, challenged outside the early leader upper stretch, proved best after a long drive in a determined effort. BIACHAMPION never far back, came three wide into the lane, outfinished after an extended stretch battle. GROUP lacked speed, came four wide into the stretch, failed muster any late gain. RARE ROBERTO clear early, set a moderate pace toward the inside, weakened when confronted turning for home. HAMMER BACK off a bit slow, picked up a couple of tiring foes while not a threat. NOONESTANDSINMYWAY steadied at the start, remained back throughout. ARCTIC KING forwardly placed along the inside, gave way in the drive. MORETHANAMOUTHFUL chased the early leader, stopped badly and was distanced.
