BIENHEUREUX with the pace from the start, shook clear in the turn, increased advantage through the stretch while being kept to task. TED'S DREAM just off the rail while behind the pace, set down for the drive, could do little with the winner, clearly second best. SPEEDY DIVA closest to the winner for a half, held the show. BEIRA CAT evenly paced throughout in lacking a late kick. FLASHY JAZZ in some traffic late in the turn, came up empty when clear for the drive. WISH I WAS steadied the opening quarter when in a bit tight, fell back and failed to make an impact. GABBY'S SONG four wide through the turn, failed to rally. BARE ELEGANCE tired from early efforts, steady fade drive. FLYING JAYBIRD remained back. ANYA MARIE bobbled at the start, unseated rider.
