Footnotes

IMAHEMI settled in the second flight early while off the inside, asked for some run while three wide exiting the turn, challenged past the furlong marker, edged clear. OPEN ME UP off the early pace, advanced four wide late in the turn, continued willingly to the wire to be slowly closing the gap on the winner. STREAM OF REDROSES dueled up front closest to the inside, fell back off the leader entering the stretch, continued inside and came back for the show while unable to match the top two. HIGH HAND dueled up front off the inside, garnered a larger advantage into the stretch, fell apart in the late going to lose the show. MYBOXOF CHOCOLATES forwardly placed early along the inside, had little for the drive. WITCH'S VALLEY sluggish in the early going, continued to trail turn, came five wide into the stretch and improved position by passing tiring foes. TIGER BULL lacked speed, four wide out of the turn, widest in the drive, never dangerous. KIOWA'S SECRET steadily retreated. FLOWER LAKE was always outrun.
